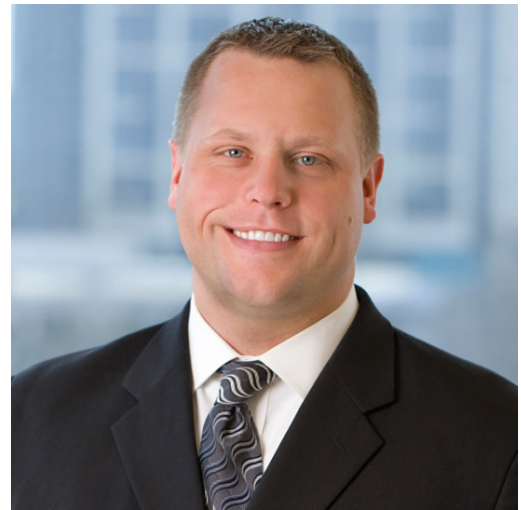
### Biography
